Completed Activities

Drafted and analyzed the 2020 annual conference survey. The 2020 conference transitioned to entirely online due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Many of the typical survey questions (conference amenities, food, etc.) were not included in the 2020 survey due to this. A conference survey summary was submitted to the Board, CPC, PPC and a shorter version was submitted for the NASIG newsletter.

Created Travel Ban survey to gather data on how many institutions have restricted travel during 2020 and 2021 due to COVID-19 pandemic. Travel bans impact the ability to hold an in-person 2021 conference.

Reminder/Updates

E&A runs on a calendar year rotation rather than July-June. Committee members will need to be updated on the website and on the E&A listserv January 2021 rather than July 2021.

The 2021 E&A Committee may need to create two surveys if the 2021 conference is held both in person in May 2021 and online. 2021 will again differ from previous years where NASIG only had an in-person conference.
